What are Camp Hours?

All camps begin at 9:00 a.m. Drop off for camp begins at 8:55.

3-year-old camp ends at 12:00 p.m.

Full day camps end at 4:00 p.m.

How are lunch and snacks handled?

A daily, nut-free snack is provided for all campers at 10:30 a.m.

Lunch period will begin at 12:00 p.m. for full day campers.

Lunch must be packed from home. We do not have food warming facilities at camp.

What should my child bring and wear?

Please bring a water bottle, sunscreen, and lunch. A closed toe or tennis shoes are required for safety reasons. Please label all personal items with your child's name. For young campers please send a full change of clothes.

What if my child requires daily medication or is injured at camp?

Camp Northridge does **not** have a full-time medical professional on staff. We do have a camp clinic area where we will assess injuries, provide basic first aid, and administer over-the-counter medications as needed. We will administer prescription medication when provided in the original container with written instructions for administration. Epi-pens and inhalers must also be provided with written instructions for appropriate use.

Please drop off all prescription medications directly to Camp Administration, Laurie Bret, Lynn Granello or Justine Patterson.

How does carpool work?

For drop off and pick up enter the church parking area from Bob-O-Link Drive. Please follow the marked cones in order to drop off from the passenger side of your car at the entrance of the education building. Please follow the same route for the afternoon pick up. On the first Monday morning of your camp, you will be provided with a carpool tag. Please show the carpool tag to camp staff to pick up your child each day.

What if I must change or cancel a camp registration?

We understand that life changes. Because we must incur fees for camp registration, we will charge a \$50 cancellation fee for all camps cancelled prior to June 1, 2024. Between June 1st and the Sunday 1 week prior to camp commencement, we will refund 50% of the original camp tuition. We are unable to refund tuition within one week of the camp commencement. We are not able to prorate camp tuition. We offer free transfer to alternate available camps.

When is my full camp payment due?

Full payment for all camps is due May 31, 2024. At that time your credit card on file will be charged for the remaining balance of your tuition. If you have changed credit cards, please visit your registration account or email campnorthridge@gmail.com to update your account information.
